CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM (CMP) MATCH

Saturday, June 19, 2010

The CMP event will be conducted in 3 relays with a max of 14 competitors in each relay. The times are: Relay One: 7:30 – 8:20 am; Relay Two: 8:20 – 9:10 am; Relay Three: 9:10 – 10:00am. The competition is open to all Summer Bash Ticket holders age 21 years and older. Sign up as soon as possible to help assure yourself of a shooting slot (see slots below).

This event is Match Format: You will shoot once for score. There will be no opportunity for practice on the day of the match. So sign up early and practice in the weeks prior to the event.

Awards will be given for First Place, Second Place, and Third Place winners. Prize money will be 1st – \$100, 2nd – \$50, and 3rd – \$25.

The CMP match will adhere to the CMP Competition Rulebook with special emphasis on General Competition Rules Section 5.0. The CMP Rule Book is available for viewing at the CMP website: www.odcmp.com . A copy of the CMP Rule Book will be made available for reference at CVWC.

The CMP event will be a Vintage Military Rifle Match as outlined in Firearms, Ammunition, and Equipment Rules Sections 6.1.1; 6.1.3; 6.2.4; 6.2.5.

Permitted rifles will include: Springfield Model 1903 and Model 1903 A-3; U.S. Model 1917 Enfield; Lee Enfield, K-98 Mauser; Mosin-Nagant; M-1 Garand; M1941 Johnson Rifles, U.S. Krag Rifles and any other foreign military as-issued manually-operated bolt action or straight-pull action rifles 1950 and older. All rifles must pass a pre-match inspection.

Commercial reproductions/equivalents of the above mentioned rifles of the same types and calibers are prohibited. Other specific exclusions (rifles that are not allowed) are: M-1 Carbines; A-R's; S-K's; A-K's; M-14's and any military rifles retro-fitted to .308 caliber.

Competitors will furnish their own ammunition in accordance with Rule 6.6.1. All other equipment must comply with CMP Rule Book sections 9.1.4; and 9.1.5. Individual coaches are allowed and encouraged.

The Match will be a John C. Garand "A" Course shooting the SR-1 reduced Bull Target at 100 yards as outlined in the CMP Rule Book Section 9.2.1 and 9.4.1. Time allowance for the rapid-

fire prone stage will be 80 seconds. In accordance with Rule Book Section 9.1.11, no alibis or refires are allowed.

All shooters must sign a liability waiver. Spectators are advised to bring their own hearing protection.
