SKEET EVENT

Saturday, June 19, 2010

The skeet event will be conducted in squads of up to five on the hour and half-hour beginning at 9:30 am. The competition is open to all Summer Bash ticket holders age 21 years and older. Sign up as soon as possible to help assure yourself of a shooting slot (see below).

You will shoot one round for score. There will be no opportunity for practice on the day of the event. Competitors must furnish their own ammunition.

The event will be conducted using Lewis Class Rules, with cash prizes for the top three scores, along these parameters:

1. Shooters must obey all safety rules posted on the High House door.
2. All decisions on judgement calls to be made by the skeet committee.
3. One gun malfunction per round – more than one will be a loss.
4. One shell failure per round – all others will be a loss.
5. Shooter error: a) safety left on, b) shell in wrong barrel – will be scored as a loss.
6. Failure to fire at a bird (balk) will be scored as a loss.
7. Breaking both birds with one shot will result in taking turn over.
8. Breaking of first bird and a piece of bird breaks second bird will result in taking turn over with scoring a hit on first bird to prove double.
9. Option must be taken immediately after miss.
10. To score a dead bird there must be a visible broken piece of the bird.
11. Shooter must be in box while shooting. No loaded gun outside of box. All guns must be open or broken outside of box.

12. A missed call by the scorer may be overturned by a majority of the shooters participating in that round.

13. Skeet tie breakers will be decided at the end of the skeet match.

All shooters must sign a liability waiver. Spectators are advised to bring their own hearing protection.
