WOBBLE TRAP EVENT

You will shoot one round for score. There will be no opportunity for practice on the day of the event. Competitors must furnish their own ammunition. Spectators are advised to bring their own hearing protection.

The event will be conducted using Lewis Class Rules, with cash prizes for the top three scores.

Rules for Wobble Trap Event

1. Keep guns pointed in a safe direction at all times.
2. Keep actions open when not in a shooting box. This means break-open shotguns are broken open, and autos and pumps have the bolt in the rear position.
3. Do not load your shotgun until you are in the box and ready to shoot.
4. Unload the shotgun before leaving the shooting box.
5. Maximum allowed load of 12 gauge 3 ¼ dram 1 1/8 ounce and # 7 1/2 shot.
6. Eye and ear protection required for all shooters, trappers, and spectators.
7. National Sporting Clays Association rules will apply (www.mynsca.com).
8. The Club reserves the right to disqualify any contestant due to a rules infraction – this would include safety infractions and any acts disruptive to the event and/or event personnel, shooters, or spectators.
9. In the event of a scoring or rules dispute, the decision of the protest committee will be final.
10. In the event of a tie for high overall, a shootoff at the end of the event will determine the winner. We will try to give shootoff scheduling consideration for those scheduled to shoot in any conflicting Egg Shoot Relay. The shootoff format will be explained to participants in the shootoff.
